Insurance requirements	<p>Before you depart, it is strongly recommended that you take out a comprehensive travel insurance policy that will cover any overseas medical costs. Confirm that your insurance covers you for the entire duration that you are away and check on the circumstances and activities not covered by your policy. The Ministry of Higher Education of Malaysia has made it compulsory for all international students to register for insurance coverage in their respective HEIs.</p>
Other relevant information	<p>All students are required to attend a medical examination once they have arrived in Malaysia in any of the EMGS Panel clinics listed (https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/how-to-apply/medical-screening/registered-overseas-clinics.html) within 7 days of arrival. Any students who fail this medical screening will not be issued with a student pass and will be required to leave the country. Cost: RM 250</p> <p>All students must obtain single-entry visa from the Malaysian Embassy of the Home Country prior to entering Malaysia.</p>
